Greeting

Whereas *The Corporations Act provides that with the exceptions therein mentioned the Lieutenant Governor may in his discretion, by Letters Patent, issue a Charter to any number of persons, not fewer than three, of twenty-one or more years of age, who apply therefor, constituting them and any others who become shareholders or members of the corporation thereby created a corporation for any of the objects to which the authority of the Legislature extends;*

And Whereas *by the said Act it is further provided that the member of the Executive Council to whom the administration of this Act is assigned may in his discretion and under the Seal of his office have, use, exercise and enjoy any power, right or authority conferred by the said Act on the Lieutenant Governor;*

And Whereas *it has been made to appear that the persons herein named have complied with the conditions precedent to the issue of the desired Charter and that the said undertaking is within the scope of the said Act;*

Now Therefore Know Ye *that, being the member of the Executive Council to whom the administration of this Act is assigned, I do by these Letters Patent issue a Charter to the Persons hereinafter named that is to say*

all of the Town of Perth, in the County of Lanark, in the
Province of Ontario; Howard George Stuart,
of the Township of North Elmsley, in the said County of
Lanark, Accountant; and Margarett Louise
Thompson, of the Township of Drummond, in the said
County of Lanark, Housewife; constituting them and any others
who become members of the Corporation hereby created a
corporation without share capital under the name of

PERTH AND DISTRICT SENIOR CRAFT FELLOWSHIP

for the following objects, that is to say:

- (a) TO promote good fellowship among the citizens of Perth and District, and in particular the senior citizens of Perth and District;
- (b) TO promote the learning of crafts among the citizens of Perth and District, and in particular the senior citizens of Perth and District;

- (c) TO provide a drop-in center for the citizens of Perth and District, and in particular the senior citizens of Perth and District;
- (d) TO provide activities for the citizens of Perth and District, and in particular for the senior citizens of Perth and District;
- (e) TO provide activities of an educational nature for the citizens of Perth and District, and in particular for the senior citizens of Perth and District;
- (f) TO provide food and beverages at the drop-in center aforesaid;
- (g) TO provide craft instructions in the craft rooms of the drop-in center aforesaid;
- (h) TO organize social and educational evenings for the citizens of Perth and District, and in particular for the senior citizens of Perth and District; and
- (i) TO provide transportation for the senior citizens of the Town of Perth to the drop-in center aforesaid and to all functions organized by the Corporation;

THE HEAD OFFICE of the Corporation to be situate at the said Town of Perth; and

THE FIRST DIRECTORS of the Corporation to be Vincent James Butler, Alberta Elizabeth Cameron, Edna Marion McAlpine, Mary Gertrude McKinnon, Georgina Matilda Relyea, Christine Elizabeth Rice, Howard George Stuart, Margarett Louise Thompson, Emma Elleanor Tysick and Alice Ida White,
