Selection, Rights and Privileges of Honourary Members

Honourary Members are either

(a) retired members of the Board of Directors of Perth Seniors Fellowship, or

(b) individuals who have completed service as an Activity Director and have been identified by the Board as individuals worthy of *special recognition* for their service to Perth Senior's Fellowship.

SELECTION

In selecting an Honourary Member, the Board may consider factors such length of service, conscientiousness in attendance and dedication to duties. Such consideration shall always be in conjunction with recognition of special accomplishments and contributions supporting accomplishment by Perth Seniors Fellowship of its objectives as identified in our Mission Statement.

RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF HONOURARY MEMBERS

An Honourary Member is:

- Exempt from the requirement to pay annual membership dues;
- Invited as a guest to commemorative ceremonies, dedication events and other special events organized by the Board, at the discretion of the Board;
- Mailed a printed copy of the Annual Report presented to Ontario Heritage Trust and the Perth Town Council;
- Eligible for on-going password-protected access to our web site archive of minutes and reports, at the discretion of the Board;
- Listed on our web site as an Honourary Member and, during their lifetime, recognized as such in membership lists accompanying our official reports and documents; and
- Listed with the names engraved on the related Plaque honouring distinguished service (located in the front hall of McMartin House).
